Film fest adds contest

The Tallahassee Film Festival has added a "24-Hour Film Contest" to the lineup of activities for the inaugural event, which will take place May 15-17, 2008. Two weeks before the festival, contestants will be given a common theme on which to base a short film. They then must create and submit their film within a one-day period. Organizers are hosting a seminar on filmmaking for interested contestants from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday at TCC Building 41, Technology & Computer Room 118. It'll offer tips on script-writing, filming, casting and editing. The cost is \$15. Another seminar will be offered April 19.
